### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

g-FleeT Management is a Trading Entity of the Gauteng Department of Roads and Transport which provides reliable, cost effective and customer focused fleet management services to Government. g-FleeT Management would like to procure a Fleet Management System that will provide the entity with the capability to manage the vehicles in its fleet including drivers. The system should have the best fleet management practices embedded in its functionality, automation of the typical fleet processes, provide alerts to the usual interventions that administrate and feed into the fleet metrics for reporting purposes.

The system must be supported by an experienced team to provide regular upgrades, training, off and on-site support services as and when required, interface with common systems in the market, including those systems within Government, and especially commonly used financial systems in the market. The system must enable g-FleeT Management to accurately and timeously (near real-time) report on the operations of its fleet.

#### **SCOPE OF WORK:**

g-Fleet Management requires a fully developed and automated Fleet Management System and support services for the management of the full life cycle of vehicles and drivers per cost center.

- The system should be scalable to allow a fleet size of above 8 000 (eight thousand) vehicles with web-access capability.
- It should accommodate modular implementation.
- It must be fully developed and tested at the time of tender submission.
- For reference purpose, there must be other corporate or organisational users of the system other than the bidding company.
- The maintenance and support services should be for a period of five (5) years

#### Please note: The detailed Terms of Reference for the RFT will be provided in the Tender document.

We adhere to all relevant Acts including the Black Economic Empowerment Act No. 53 of 2003, Preferential Procurement Policy Act No. 5 of 2000, Employment Equity Act No. 55 of 1998.

In terms of Preferential Procurement Regulation of 2011 the 90/10 preference point system is applicable. Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) requires that bidders submit original and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies thereof to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. Failure to submit such a certificate will result in the bidder not qualifying for preference points for B-BBEE. The bidders must submit verification certificates that are accredited by:

- SANAS (South African National Accredited System)
- IRBA (Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors)





Points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

A trust, consortium or joint venture must obtain and submit a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level Verification
Certificate with their bids. Failure to submit a consolidated B-BBEE status Verification Certificate for the
Consortium or Joint Venture will result in the entity not to be awarded points for B-BBEE.

### **TENDERERS SHOULD NOTE THE FOLLOWING**

- Functionality will be scored out of 100 points and the minimum threshold to qualify is 75 points. Bidders who fail to
  meet the minimum threshold will not be considered for further evaluation.
- Bidders must submit contactable references for verification of the current projects.
- Bidders who are listed on National Treasury Register of Tender Defaulters and on list of Restricted Suppliers will automatically be disqualified.
- Bidders may be required to do live presentations of their proposed system.
- The Department reserves the right to conduct user / customer site visits and interview Officials whose references
  have been submitted for verification.
- All the SBD Forms must be signed and completed in full.

A non-refundable tender fee of R 300.00 (Three hundred rand) is payable in <u>cash only</u>. Tender documents will be available for collection from 06 July 2015, only during the stipulated working hours (between 08H00 and 15h00) from g-FleeT Management.

A compulsory site briefing session will be held on Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2015, 11H00 at No. 16 Boeing Road East, Bedfordview, g-fleeT Management.

A two envelope system will be used. The Technical Proposals and Financial Proposals shall be submitted in two plain envelope clearly marked with the Bid No and Bid Description for the project tendered for and must be deposited in the Tender Box located in the foyer at the reception area of No. 16 Boeing Road East, Bedfordview, g-FleeT Management.
